### **National Taxpayers United of Illinois Endorse State Senator Randy Hultgren For U.S. House of Representatives**

Prior to serving in the Senate, Hultgren served the 95th District in the Illinois House since 1999. He was first elected in 1994 to the DuPage County Commission and Forest Preserve Commission.
